To the Commission,

We request RECONSIDERATION of our application of KZJG-LP for eligibility for Class A Television Service.

1) Application was performed in a timely matter and before the January 28,2000 deadline.

2) In our attached "Exhibit #1" of our original application:

a) We indicated we were "off-air" for seven (7) days during the 90 day qualification period. However; we did not indicate that this was due to transmitter malfunctions beyond our control. Repairs were made as promptly as possible. We additionally operated 24 hours per day 7 days per week which allowed a total accumulated hours of service to the community during this 90 day period much greater than a station that operates only the minimum of 18 hours per day.

b) We indicated that we did not meet the three (3) hour per week average of programing produced within our market area during the 90 day period. However; we did run locally produced programs averaging 1.5-2.0 hours per week and intend to expand to at least 3.0 hours per week.

c) We have been in compliance with the Commission's regulations applicable to the low power television service.

3) We are not and have never been absentee operators of KZJG-LP. Since our inital sign-on in the mid 1980's we have "lived in" the "grade A" coverage area of this television station and have maintained a "studio" within the "grade A" coverage area of this television station. All members of ownership of KZJG-LP have and do live within the "grade A" coverage area of KZJG-LP. Thus; this is

an example of our commitment and dedication to the community this television service operates within.


We operate 24/7 and do not air primarily home shopping and/or religious programming ; but, air quality variety and informational programming that would not otherwise be available to the community.

Statement of Eligibility for Class A Low Power Television Station Status:

A) Minimum of 18 hours/day broadcast.

We operate 24 hours/ 7 days per week; however, we were "off-air" for seven (7) days during the 90-day period ending Nov. 28, 1999. However; our average operating ours was greater than 18 hours per day during this period.

B) Average of three (3) hour per week of programing produced within the market during the above period.

We did not meet the three (3) hour per week average. However; we do run locally produced programs averaging 1.5-2.0 hour per week. We began operations in the mid 1980's and have aired quality variety programing for the community. We do not air 24/7 home shopping or religous programing and in many instances we provide programing that would not otherwise be avaiable to our community.
