

Dear Ms. Salas:

Philip Verveer and myself, on behalf of Teligent, Inc., met yesterday with Kathryn Brown, the Chief of Staff in the Chairman's Office, and James Schlichting, Deputy Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, to discuss the various bases of the Commission's jurisdiction to ensure nondiscriminatory telecommunications carrier access to multi-tenant buildings. Specifically, we explained that the Commission possesses jurisdiction over multi-tenant building owners that provide telecommunications service, noted that the Commission could adopt nondiscriminatory access rules using its ancillary jurisdiction and its plenary jurisdiction over interstate radio and wire communication, explained the application of Section 224 of the Communications Act to nondiscriminatory access efforts, and discussed the ability to accomplish nondiscriminatory access indirectly through requirements placed on telecommunications carriers themselves. Because our meeting concerned a pending rulemaking at the Commission, in accordance with the Commission's rules, for each of the above-mentioned proceedings, I hereby submit to the Secretary of the Commission two copies of this notice of Teligent's ex parte presentation.
