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Statement of Party's Interests

The Durham Unified School District (DUSD) is a local education agency in Butte County, California, which is eligible for discounted technology services under the ERATE program administered by the Universal Service Administrative Company, Schools and Libraries Division (SLD). DUSD's ERATE discount rate is 60% for the 2000-2001 year.

Statement of Relevant Facts

The Durham Unified School District filed a Schools and Libraries Universal Services Ordered and Certification Form (FCC Form 471, attachment 1), receipt and successful data entry of which was acknowledged by the Universal Service Administrative Company, Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) on February 7, 2000 (attachment 2)). On May 12, 2000, the SLD issued its Funding Commitment Report (attachment 3), wherein it denied funding of the Form 471. The Funding Commitment Decision Explanation states: "Category of service was changed from Internet Access to Internal Connections. The funding cap will not provide 81% discount to be funded." An appeal (attachment 4) was timely filed on June 12, 2000. On June 15, the SLD issued an Administrator's Decision on Appeal (attachment 5) denying the appeal on the basis it was received more than 30 days after the date of the Funding Commitment Decision.

Question for Review

1. It is clear that the category of service for this Form 471 is "Internet Access". The service provider's contract included with attachment 1 clearly states such. Although Internal Connections are not funded below 81%, Internet Access is funded for all applicants. In changing the category of service from Internet Access where the application would have been funded, the SLD has prohibited DUSD from receiving the discount to which it is entitled in the amount of \$5,969.23. Had this been left in tact and as originally filed, no appeal would be necessary.
2. The Since the 30th day after May 12 fell on a Sunday when the SLD was not open to receive correspondence, receipt of the appeal on the next business day should be considered timely.

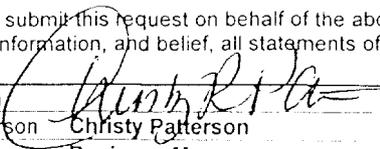

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INTERNET ACCESS AGREEMENT
(Narrative of Service Procurement)

This agreement is between the Durham Unified School District (District) and the Butte County Office of Education (BCOE).

District is a member of the Butte Education Network Consortium, an association of public school districts serving grades kindergarten through 12 in Butte County, California. The Consortium plans to obtain Internet services which, described in detail below, include setup, maintenance and troubleshooting of networking equipment owned by the Consortium. The services will be provided under contracts with Butte County Office of Education (BCOE) conforming to California's Education and Public Contracts Codes. Internet service agreement(s) made between Consortium member school districts and Butte County Office of Education will depend upon Schools and Library Corporation approving Consortium's request for subsidy under the Telecommunications Act of 1996 for the services described.

1. Internet Services: BCOE will provide Consortium member districts these specific Internet services in accordance with accepted telecommunication industry standards within the judgement of BCOE's professional staff, Bylaws of the Butte Education Network Consortium and, when applicable, Federal Communication Commission rules for Universal Service Fund (E-Rate) subsidy under the Telecommunications Act of 1996:

- 1.1. Install and configure Internet equipment and software, particularly hub routers, approved by Consortium to be jointly owned by districts.
- 1.2. Provide District access to the Internet through one or more paths.
- 1.3. Maintain and operate one or more Internet servers to provide districts with web browser and e-mail service including one e-mail account for each district workstation connected via network or five (5) e-mail accounts per site for sites using dialup access.
- 1.4. Install and configure Internet equipment and software, particularly site routers, owned by districts.
- 1.5. Purchase, at district's expense, install and configure CSU/DSUs to accommodate data circuits that require them.
- 1.6. Respond, electronically or by on-site visit, to district problem reports in accordance prescribed definitions and standards.
- 1.7. Maintain Help Desk to monitor network status and respond to districts' requests for assistance with Internet accessing equipment and software.
- 1.8. At individual district's expense, install a low cost domain name server to maintain district's Internet access if Consortium's main servers are not available.
- 1.9. Maintain a database of IP addresses for districts with a process for issuing new IP addresses.
- 1.10. Compile equipment usage statistics and intervene, when possible, before overloads occur.

- 1.11. Troubleshoot Internet accessing equipment to identify specific problems and reduce repairs.
- 1.12. Document configuration data on all Internet accessing equipment to facilitate repair or replacement.
- 1.13. Install operating system upgrades in all Internet equipment named in this Agreement.
- 1.14. Coordinate repair or replacement of Internet equipment and maintain interchangeable spares to reestablish service as soon as reasonably possible.
- 1.15. Troubleshoot data circuits to identify specific problems and reduce repair time where possible.
- 1.16. Compile statistics for circuit usage and, where possible, intervene before overloads occur.
- 1.17. Coordinate data circuit repair with providers.
- 1.18. Prepare equipment standards to facilitate quantity purchases, easy support and ready spares.

2. Services Not Provided:

- 2.1. Use of wide area network circuits.
- 2.2. Installation, configuration or maintenance for local area network servers.
- 2.3. Network cable installation; or
- 2.4. Installation, configuration or maintenance of local workstations.
- 2.5. Media, text or other information content beyond that needed for districts to transmit and receive information over the Internet.

3. Content:

BCOE will not provide Internet content to districts and will not warrant, or accept any responsibility whatsoever, for the appropriateness of any content passing over this network or for appropriate use by districts licensees.

4. Assured Levels of Service:

BCOE will account to districts for levels of service rendered reports in accordance prescribed definitions and standards.
