
Re: Ex Parte Presentation in WT Docket No. 99-217 and CC Docket No. 96-98

Dear Ms. Salas:

David Turetsky of Teligent, Inc. discussed briefly today with Kathryn Brown, the Chief of Staff in the Chairman's Office, issues concerning the provision of nondiscriminatory telecommunications carrier access to multi-tenant buildings. Specifically, he emphasized the importance of a Commission rule proscribing discriminatory practices against telecommunications carriers seeking to gain access to consumers in multi-tenant environments and explained the potential enforcement mechanisms available to the Commission should it adopt such a rule.

Because these topics concern a pending rulemaking at the Commission, in accordance with the Commission's rules, for each of the above-mentioned proceedings, I hereby submit to the Secretary of the Commission two copies of this notice of Teligent's ex parte presentation.
