On July 26, 2000, the Cellular Telecommunications Industry Association ("CTIA") represented by Brian Fontes, Senior Vice President for Regulatory Policy Law and Administration, and Douglas Brandon, AT&T Wireless, Catheryn Zachem, Wilkinson Bauker and Knauer representing Quest Wireless LLC, Lawrence Krevor, Nextel, Karen Posner, Bell South, Jonathan Cohen, Wilkinson Bauker and Knauer representing Quest Wireless LLC, Robert Petit, Wiley Rein and Fielding, Jonathan Scott, Verizon, Glenn Kennedy, Dow Lohnes & Albertson met with Tom Sugrue, Wireless Bureau Chief, Catherine Ham, Wireless Bureau, Diane Cornell, Wireless Bureau, Walter Stat, Wireless Bureau, Kelly Quinn, Wireless Bureau, Gary Micheal, Wireless Bureau. The parties discussed issues related to the auction of licenses in the 747 –762 and 777 – 792 MHz bands. Specifically, the parties discussed delaying the auction of licenses in the 700 MHz band, holding a longer "mock auction" with a longer period between the testing of software and the actual auction, and issues regarding the 700 MHz band clearing proposals. CTIA's position is set forth in the written ex parte submission attached hereto.
