ORDER

Adams Communications Corporation (“Adams”) filed a Motion for Leave to File Informational Statement on July 11, 2000. The time has passed for the filing of an opposing pleading and none has been filed. 47 C.F.R. §1.294 (oppositions and replies).

The subject of the Statement is the revival of Adams’ corporate status as a Massachusetts corporation. Adams represents that its corporate status was involuntarily dissolved in August 1998. (Tr. 2523, 2552). According to a “Revival Certificate”, Adams’ corporate status has been revived as was expected. (Tr. 2558.) It was also expected that Adams would amend the record to show the present corporate status.

Accordingly, for cause shown, there being no opposition, the Motion for Leave to File Informational Statement that was filed on July 11, 2000, IS GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Informational Statement of Adams Communications Corporation, a related Declaration of Howard N. Gilbert dated July 11, 2000, and the Revival Certificate of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts dated June 27, 2000, ARE ACCEPTED.¹
