This letter is submitted on behalf of Celsat America, Inc. ("Celsat") to notify you that yesterday David Otten, President and CEO of Celsat, Antoinette Cook Bush and I met with Mark Schneider of Commissioner Ness's office. In addition, following the meeting with Mr. Schneider, David Otten and I met with Adam Krinsky of Commissioner Tristani's office. At these meetings, Celsat reiterated its position – as previously expressed in its comments in the above-referenced proceeding – that it would willingly accept a Commission mandate to meet enhanced 911 requirements. In addition, at both meetings Celsat urged the Commission to act expeditiously on the 2 GHz MSS licensing order so that Celsat can provide its much needed services to the American public as soon as possible.
