This letter is submitted on behalf of Celsat America, Inc. ("Celsat") to notify you that yesterday David Otten, President and CEO of Celsat, Antoinette Cook Bush and I met with Commissioner Furchtgott-Roth and his intern, Gardner Foster. In addition, following the meeting in Commissioner Furchtgott-Roth's office, David Otten and I met with Peter Tenhula of Commissioner Powell's office. At these meetings, Celsat reiterated its position – as previously expressed in its comments in the above-referenced proceeding – that it would willingly accept a Commission mandate to meet enhanced 911 requirements. In addition, at both meetings Celsat urged the Commission to act expeditiously on the 2 GHz MSS licensing order so that Celsat can provide its much needed services to the American public as soon as possible.
