By the Deputy Chief, Accounting Policy Division:

This Order dismisses the Letter of Appeal of the Kerman Unified School District (Kerman), Kerman, California, seeking review of a decision issued by the Universal Service Administrative Company's Schools and Libraries Division on April 3, 2000. The Commission received Kerman's Letter of Appeal on May 17, 2000. Under section 54.720 of the Commission's rules, any such appeal must be filed within 30 days of the issuance of the decision as to which review is sought. Documents are considered to be filed with the Commission only upon receipt.
