SUBJECT: AT&T Corp. v. FCC & USA, No. 99-1541. Filing of a Petition for Review in the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.

This is to advise you that, on December 29, 1999, AT&T Corp. filed a Petition for Review pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 402(a) of: Implementation of the Cable Television Consumer Protection and Competition Act of 1992; Implementation of Cable Act Reform Provisions of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 - Review of the Commission's Cable Attribution Rules CS Docket Nos. 98-82 and 96-85, FCC 99-288 (released October 20, 1999).

AT&T Corp. challenges the Commission's rules for determining what ownership interests are attributable to cable operators for purposes of implementing the subscriber limit and other FCC regulations.
