This is to advise you that, on November 24, 1999, People of the State of New York and the Public Service Commission of the State of New York filed a new Petition for Review pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 402(a) of: Implementation of the Local Competition Provisions of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, et al., Second Report and Order and Memorandum Opinion and Order, CC Docket No. 96-98, et al., 11 FCC Rcd 19392 (1996) and Third Order on Reconsideration of Second Report and Order and Memorandum Opinion and Order, CC Docket No. 96-98, et al., FCC 99-243 (released October 21, 1999).

Petitioners challenge the FCC's decision to mandate 10-digit dialing for all telephone calls between and within area codes in New York City.

The Court has docketed this case as No. 99-4205. The attorney assigned to handle the litigation of this case is James M. Carr.
