This is to advise you that Advanced Paging, Inc. d/b/a Advanced Paging, Mark A. Apsley d/b/a Progressive Paging, Capitol Radiotelephone Company, Inc. d/b/a Capitol Paging, Express Message Corporation, A.V. Luttamus Communications, Inc. d/b/a Luttamus Communications, and NEP, LLC d/b/a Northeast Paging on June 24, 1999, filed a 402(a) Petition for Review of: Future Development of Paging Systems, WT Docket No. 96-18 and PR Docket No. 93-253, FCC 99-98 (released May 24, 1999).

Petitioners challenge the above-referenced order which made certain clarifications and adopted certain new rules to govern the system of geographic licensing for nonnationwide paging channels previously adopted by the FCC in this proceeding.
