ORDER

Issued: August 16, 2000 Released: August 18, 2000

On July 27, 2000, the Enforcement Bureau filed and submitted for consideration a fully executed Stipulation and Request for Receipt Into Evidence of Enforcement Bureau Exhibit 2 ("Stipulation").

The Stipulation has an attached letter dated May 22, 1997, from Barbara A. Kreisman, Chief Video Division, Mass Media Bureau addressed to Allan C. Campbell, Esquire, showing a copy to Howard A. Topel, Esquire. The letter granted an assignment of the license for Station WHRC(TV), Norwell, Ma., by Massachusetts Redevelopment Limited Liability Company to Channel 46 of Boston, Inc. (FCC File No. BALCT - 961007IA).

The assignor, Massachusetts Redevelopment Limited Liability Company, was controlled by Mr. Micheal L. Parker.

During this proceeding's hearing session of July 25, 2000, Mr. Parker testified about the letter which had sufficient significance for Parker's testimony to permit the record to remain open to receive the letter in evidence. (Tr. 2653-2654, 2687-2688).

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Stipulation and Request for Receipt Into Evidence of Enforcement Bureau Exhibit 2 IS ACCEPTED AND GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the document which is described as a May 22, 1997, letter, consisting of two pages, from Barbara A. Kreisman, Chief Video Services Division, Mass Media Bureau, to Alan C. Campbell, Esquire, with a copy to Howard A. Topel, Esquire, being the letter referenced in Mr. Parker's testimony, IS MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION and IS HEREBY RECEIVED INTO EVIDENCE as Enforcement Bureau (EB) Exhibit 2.¹

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that except for the submission of Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and the Replies, the hearing record of this case IS CLOSED. See 47 F.C.C. 1.258.
