
Re: Ex Parte Presentation in WT Docket No. 99-217 and CC Docket Nos. 96-98/99-68;

Dear Ms. Salas:

Yesterday afternoon, Larissa Herda, Kelsi Reeves, and Chuck Boto and I, on behalf of Time Warner Telecom, met with Chairman Kennard, Kathryn Brown, Clint Odom, and Thomas Sugrue in connection with the above-referenced dockets. We discussed the need for prompt Commission action in the *Competitive Networks* docket to ensure that CLECs are able to bring their competitive services to consumers living or working in multi-tenant buildings. We also discussed the application of reciprocal compensation to the exchange of ISP-bound traffic and CLEC access charges, reiterating the points made in Time Warner Telecom's comments and reply comments in CC Docket Nos. 96-98, 99-68, and 96-262.

Because these topics concern pending rulemakings at the Commission, in accordance with the Commission's rules, for each of the above-mentioned proceedings, I hereby submit to the Secretary of the Commission two copies of this notice of Time Warner Telecom's ex parte presentation.
