

Dear Ms. Salas:

On September 6, 2000, Larissa Herda and Kelsi Reeves of Time Warner Telecom (TWTC) and I, on behalf of TWTC, discussed the application of reciprocal compensation to the exchange of ISP-bound traffic with Anna Gomez, Legal Advisor to Chairman William Kennard. During the meeting, we asked that the Chairman respond to congressional inquiries regarding progress in the above-referenced dockets with a statement that the FCC will soon release a comprehensive order addressing the application of reciprocal comprehension to ISP-bound traffic.
