
Re: Ex Parte Presentation in WT Docket No. 99-217 and CC Docket No. 96-98

Dear Ms. Salas:

Yesterday afternoon, on behalf of the Smart Buildings Policy Project, David Turetsky of Teligent, Inc., and Philip Verveer and the undersigned (both of Willkie Farr & Gallagher) met with Kathryn Brown, Chief of Staff in the Office of Chairman Kennard, and James Schlichting, Deputy Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. During the course of that meeting, we discussed issues concerning the appropriate interpretation of Section 224 as it relates to multi-tenant environments, the effect of the *Gulf Power II* decision on the scope of Section 224, and the ability of the Commission to utilize indirect means in order to accomplish nondiscriminatory telecommunications carrier access to tenants in multi-tenant buildings.

Because these topics concern a pending rulemaking at the Commission, in accordance with the Commission's rules, for each of the above-mentioned proceedings, I hereby submit to the Secretary of the Commission two copies of this notice of the Smart Buildings Policy Project's ex parte presentation.
