

Dear Ms. Salas:

Pursuant to the Commission's *ex parte* rules, this letter is written to notify you that on September 29, 2000, International Bureau staff met with representatives of Aerospace & Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council ("AFTRCC"), Sirius Satellite Radio Inc. ("Sirius") and XM Satellite Radio Inc. ("XM") to discuss the coordination of SDARS terrestrial repeaters with the S-band facilities of AFTRCC's members. The FCC staff included Tom Tycz, Ron Repasi, and Rockie Patterson. AFTRCC was represented by Ken Keane and Dan Jablonski. Sirius was represented by Mark Guadino and Carl Frank. XM Radio was represented by Lon Levin, Phil Barsky, and Bruce Jacobs.

The parties discussed the coordination agreement between AFTRCC and XM filed with the Commission on September 11, 2000 and the likely negotiation of a similar agreement between AFTRCC and Sirius.
