Pursuant to the Commission's *ex parte* rules, this letter is written to notify you that on October 6, 2000, Cheryl Crate and John Hane, representatives of Pegasus Broadband Corporation, and Bruce Jacobs and Tom Yancy, counsel for Pegasus, met with Mark Schneider, legal advisor to Commissioner Ness.

In the meeting, Pegasus reiterated the position it has taken in written submissions to the Commission, that it has a legitimate right to full consideration of its application to provide terrestrial services in the Ku band. Pegasus also emphasized that the Commission's *ex parte* rules for restricted proceedings apply with respect to contacts with the Commission regarding among other things the merits of the mutually exclusive terrestrial applications.
