
Dear Ms. Salas:

On Monday, October 23, 2000, Leonard J. Kennedy, counsel for Nextel Communications, Inc., met with Clint Odom, Legal Advisor to Chairman William E. Kennard, regarding the above-referenced proceeding.

During the meeting, they discussed approaches to advance spectrum efficiency by eliminating restrictions on the use of fungible spectrum and the importance of allowing Business and Industrial/Land Transportation licensees the flexibility to transfer voluntarily their licenses to commercial mobile radio service providers or to engage in joint ventures with commercial providers.
