

AMENDMENT TO COUNTERPROPOSAL

WRUS, Inc. ("Petitioner"), licensee of Radio Station WBVR(FM), Bowling Green, Kentucky, by its counsel, hereby files an amendment to the "Counterproposal" filed on December 27, 1999 in the above-referenced rulemaking. In support thereof the following is respectfully shown:


1. Petitioner's Counterproposal requested that the Commission substitute Channel 244C2 for Channel for 244A and reallocate the channel from Bowling Green, Kentucky to Auburn, Kentucky and modify Radio Station WBVR-FM's license accordingly; substitute Channel 255A for Channel 244A at Byrdstown, Tennessee and substitute Channel 297A for Channel 244A and reallocate the channel from Bardstown to Lebanon Junction, Kentucky and modify Radio Station WOKH(FM)'s license accordingly. Included in that Counterproposal was a "Consent" from the then-licensee of WOKH(FM), CBC of Nelson County, Inc., consenting to Petitioner's request.

2. Pursuant to File BALH-19991213AAT, Western Kentucky Radio, LLC became the licensee of WOKH(FM), Bardstown, Kentucky on March 15, 2000. As a result, Petitioner is herewith filing a revised consent on behalf of Western Kentucky Radio, LLC which also agrees to the modification of the reference point coordinates, the change of channel, change of community of license from Bardstown to Lebanon Junction, Kentucky and the modification of WOKH(FM)'s license accordingly.

3. Furthermore, in light of the fact that there is common ownership between WRUS, Inc. and Western Kentucky Radio, LLC, there is no need for WRUS, Inc. to compensate or reimburse Western Kentucky Radio, LLC for any of its expenses that result from the instant rulemaking and no such agreement exists, either oral or written.

CONSENT

The undersigned, Western Kentucky Radio, LLC, became the licensee of WOKH(FM), Bardstown, Kentucky on March 15, 2000 pursuant to BALH-19991213AAT and as such hereby consents to the "Comments and Counterproposal" filed by WRUS, Inc., licensee of Radio Station WBVR(FM), Bowling Green, Kentucky on December 27, 1999 in MM Docket No. 99-326. WRUS, Inc.'s "Comments and Counterproposal" specifically propose, with respect to WOKH: (a) modification of reference point coordinates to 37, 45', 55" North, 85, 37', 48" West; (b) change of channel to 297A; (c) reallocation of Channel 297A from Bardstown, Kentucky to Lebanon Junction, Kentucky, and (d) the modification of WOKH(FM)'s license accordingly. When the changes to the Table of Allotments are authorized, Western Kentucky Radio, LLC will build the modified facilities promptly and commence operation.

There is common ownership between WRUS, Inc., the Petitioner, and Western Kentucky Radio, LLC. Consequently, there is no agreement between WRUS, Inc. and Western Kentucky Radio, LLC for the reimbursement of Western Kentucky Radio, LLC by WRUS, Inc. for engineering, legal or construction expenses by Western Kentucky Radio, LLC that result from the instant rulemaking.
