Dear Congressman Udall:

Thank you for your letter expressing the concerns of Dr. Judy Margrath-Huge regarding the application filed by the Adams Twelve Five Star Schools for support under the schools and libraries universal service support mechanism. As you know, the Commission is dedicated to promoting access to telecommunications services in schools and libraries pursuant to section 254(h) of the Communications Act of 1934.

Consistent with our obligation to review appeals of decisions made by the Schools and Libraries Division of the Universal Service Administrative Company, we currently have the Adams Twelve Five Star Schools' appeal under consideration. Although I am unable to comment on the merits of this appeal while it remains under review, I will ensure that your letter is placed on the record for consideration in this proceeding. We expect to issue a decision on the appeal in the near future. A copy of the decision will be sent to the Adams Twelve Five Star Schools.
