Today, Robert Kaiser, Bob Koppell and I met with Peter Tenhula, legal advisor to Commissioner Michael Powell regarding the above referenced proceeding.

The meeting focused on WorldCom's current wireless broadband business plans using the MMDS spectrum. We discussed the important benefits associated with bringing high speed broadband service to currently unserved and under-served markets across the country. Finally, we addressed the importance of maintaining MMDS and ITFS licenses at their current location in the radio spectrum. No written documents were provided as part of the meetings.
