

Intercarrier Compensation for ISP-Bound Traffic

Dear Secretary Salas,

Pursuant to Section 1.1206(a) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. 1.1206(a), this letter is to provide notice of *ex parte* meetings by John Windhausen and Jonathan Askin of the Association for Local Telecommunications Services, Bob Taylor, CEO of Focal Communications, and Rich Rindler on behalf of Focal Communications in the above-referenced proceeding on Monday, December 11, 2000. In four separate meetings, the parties met with Commissioner Furchtgott-Roth and Rebecca Beynon, Chairman Kennard and Anna Gomez, Commissioner Ness and Jordan Goldstein, and Dorothy Attwood. The parties discussed the appropriate forms of compensation that should apply to ISP-bound traffic terminated between interconnected local carriers, emphasizing that terminating CLECs must be justly compensated for terminating ILEC traffic.
