

Dear Mr. Dever:

On December 1, 2000 BellSouth filed a petition for conditional waiver of the requirement that it provide physical collocation arrangements within 90 days of receiving an acceptable collocation application in those states in which the state commission has not yet set its own interval standard. On December 18, 2000 in a conversation with Richard Sbaratta of BellSouth, you asked for BellSouth to identify in writing those states in its region that have not set a provisioning interval standard pursuant to one of the methods set forth in the Order on Reconsideration in CC Docket No. 98-147 (released August 10, 2000). In response to your request I am writing to tell you that the three states in BellSouth's region that have not set such intervals are Alabama, North Carolina and Tennessee
