**Subject: Pole Attachment Application No. 99-1**

We have reviewed the subject application per the terms of our License Agreement. Permission is granted to attach to the poles subject to the following conditions:

1. Attachment height is too high at poles #1,#2,#3, and #4. Relocate your facilities so that they are only 12 inches above existing Pacific Bell telephone attachments. At pole #4, relocate your facilities to an attachment height no greater than 24 feet, 10 inches.
2. Pole #4 is scheduled to be removed per our agreement with the property owner to provide space for a commercial building to be constructed by the summer of 2000. Note that your facilities at this location must also be completely removed prior to this time. We understand that the property owner or developer has been in contact with you concerning this project.
3. The sag tension data as initially submitted with your application was incorrect. At the meeting with your consultant on December 17 to discuss this issue, they agreed that the information was not correct and that they would resubmit corrected data. I received the new sag tension data on December 21. After reviewing the summary information contained in this partial submittal (detailed information is being sent separately and I have not received it yet as of this time), I believe that there continue to be errors in the sag tension values. However, rather than unnecessarily delay the application process, I have used what I believe to be the correct sag tension values to evaluate your proposed attachments until such time as we can come to mutual agreement. I will be in contact in the near future with you and your consultant, Wilson Lee Communications, to resolve this issue. This issue should be resolved prior to submitting additional applications.
4. This approval is for the overlashing of fiber optic cable to existing messenger supported cables only, and does not apply to other any new pole-mounted facilities, including power supplies, splice enclosures, etc. If you wish to install these types of facilities, they must be clearly indicated on applications made to the District. Per District policy, we do not allow these facilities to be pole-mounted but will consider requests to do so on a case by case basis.

**Subject: Pole Attachment Application No. 99-2**

We have reviewed the subject application per the terms of our License Agreement. Permission is granted to attach to the poles subject to the following conditions:

1. Pole attachments to be modified as follows:
  - a. Pole No. 1 (#15549): Anchor your cables at this structure, not at Pole No. 2 (see next item).
  - b. Pole No. 2: Install a guard arm above your cables. Your facilities cannot be raised due to clearance limitations to secondary supply conductors. There are electric risers at this pole which preclude the use of guys for your facilities.
  - c. Pole No. 3: Your facilities are installed at a height greater than we would normally allow to provide the necessary clearances to our facilities. We realize that these attachment heights are necessary to maintain the proper clearances above Glenshire Drive because of the extremely long span of 275 feet between Pole No. 2 and Pole No. 3, under which Glenshire Drive is located. However, proper clearances to our facilities must be maintained which necessitates that this pole must be replaced with a taller structure. We estimate approximately 16 hours of crew time to replace this 45 foot class 3 pole with a 50' class 3 pole for a labor cost of \$3,700. Existing electric materials can be re-used and this pole is in good condition, so we would only charge the difference in cost between a 45 and 50 foot pole, about \$250. The total cost then to replace this pole is about \$3,950. Please confirm your intentions to install facilities at this structure so that we can prepare an invoice and schedule crew time.
  - d. Pole Nos. 4, 5 (#14856), 6 (#14882), 7 (#AWL74), 8 (#14932), 9 (#14956), and 11(#14982) : Relocate your facilities so that they are only 12 inches above existing Pacific Bell telephone attachments. Note that your facilities should normally be installed 12 inches from existing telephone attachments. By installing your attachments incorrectly and then having to move them to the correct height, an unnecessary hole was drilled which weakens the pole. This is a prime example of why applications are required before facilities are initially installed.

- e. Pole No. 10 (#14982): Per District policy, we no longer allow power supplies or meter bases to be pole-mounted. Since you are modifying facilities at this location, we will require that you conform to our current standards. Therefore, you must remove the existing meter base and power supply from the pole and relocate them to ground level using pedestal type facilities.
2. This approval constitutes 13 additional attachments.

Since the time of my previous letter dated December 22, I have received the complete submittal of revised sag tension information from your consultant, Wilson Lee Communications. After reviewing this information in detail, I believe that the revised sag tension values are correct. If USA Media plans to install a combination of messenger and cables different from what is currently represented, please send me the appropriate information so that I can update this document.

Note that for any existing G.O. 95 infraction not discovered during the application process, infraction created subsequent to our approval, or infractions caused because facilities were installed contrary to our specific approval, it will be USA Media's responsibility to correct the problem at its expense and in a timely manner.

In addition, our approval of this or any future applications does not constitute a grant of easement through or across public or private property including California Department of Transportation property, Union Pacific Railroad property, private property owners, or others. It is USA Media's responsibility to make separate application for easement to the appropriate agency or property owner.



We have reviewed the subject application per the terms of our License Agreement. Permission is granted to attach to the poles subject to the following conditions:

1. Pole attachments to be modified as follows:

- a) Pole No. 1: Your facilities do not meet clearance requirements to our secondary supply conductors, even with the use of a guard arm. Either (1) relocate your attachment below the existing telephone attachment and install a guard arm, or (2) relocate both your attachment and the telephone attachment to a level 6 feet below your current attachment height. If you decide on the latter option, it will be your responsibility to coordinate the work with the phone company.
- b) Pole Nos. 3 and 4: Your facilities are installed at a height greater than we would normally allow to provide the necessary clearances to our facilities. While these attachment heights may be necessary to maintain the proper clearances above Interstate 80, we may in the future decide to install additional facilities at this crossing. Also, since a copy of your Caltrans encroachment permit was not attached to the application, we assume that you will be applying for a permit, and that Caltrans may require modifications to meet their standards. Therefore, we grant conditional approval to attach to these poles subject to receiving a copy of your encroachment permit from Caltrans. If taller poles or other modifications are required by Caltrans, or if the District adds facilities at a later date, we will perform the work at your expense. Note that in the future, we expect to see a copy of applicable encroachment permits or licenses with your application, pursuant to Section 12 of our License Agreement.
- c) Pole No. 10 (#10016): Per District policy, we no longer allow power supplies or meter bases to be pole-mounted. Since you are modifying facilities at this location, we will require that you conform to our current standards. Therefore, you must remove the existing meter base and power supply from the pole and relocate them to ground level using pedestal type facilities.
- d) Pole No. 11: Relocate your facilities to a point at least 6 feet below your present attachment height i.e., no higher than 30 feet above ground at this structure.

- e) Pole No. 12: Relocate your facilities to a point at least 2 feet below your present attachment height i.e., no higher than 23 feet above ground at this structure. The District will be installing a primary riser at this pole and the overhead span between pole nos. 12 and 13 will be removed.
- f) Pole No. 13: Conditional approval is granted to attach at this structure as the District will be removing its poles along Jibboom Street and placing our facilities underground during 2000.

We have reviewed the subject application per the terms of our License Agreement. Permission is granted to attach to the poles subject to the following conditions:

1. Pole attachments to be modified as follows:

- a) Pole No. 1: Relocate your facilities so that they are attached 12 inches above the topmost existing Pacific Bell telephone attachments. We note that this may require you to modify the preceding structure (which is not at part of this application) in order to achieve the necessary clearance above Highway 267 as required by Caltrans. If modifications to the preceding pole and span are necessary, among the options you may consider, and there may be others, are:
  - 1) replacing your preceding pole with a taller pole, 2) installing an interset pole on the east side of the entrance road into the District's Truckee Substation, 3) obtaining permission from Sierra Pacific to attach to their pole in that same vicinity. If you decide on placing a new interset pole, contact the District so that we can coordinate the location of the pole with our entrance road.

If you proceed with modifications to the preceding pole and span, please provide us with a copy of your Caltrans encroachment permit, as Caltrans may require modifications to meet their standards which would affect our Pole No. 1. Therefore, we grant conditional approval to attach to Pole No. 1 subject to the above relocation requirement and (if you modify the preceding pole) to receiving a copy of your encroachment permit from Caltrans. If modifications are required by Caltrans which affect our Pole No. 1, we will perform the work at your expense.

- b) Pole Nos. 5, 6 (#10535), and 22 (#10881): Your facilities are installed far and away above the normal and typical attachment heights for communications facilities on a 45 foot pole and seriously encroach upon space the District reserves for electric facilities. Relocate your attachment such that your attachment is no higher than 24 feet, 10 inches above the ground. It will be your responsibility to coordinate the work with Pacific Bell to lower the telephone cable attachments first, so that you can relocate your facilities. In accordance with Section 3 the

License Agreement, please inform us prior to performing the work so that we can verify compliance with the above conditions.

- c) Pole Nos. 7, 18 (#10807), 21 (#10867), 23, "C" (#11061), and "D" (#11079): Relocate your facilities so that they are 12 inches above the topmost existing Pacific Bell telephone attachments. Note that we question the accuracy of your field measurements for HOAs as shown on the sketch for pole 18. Please provide us with an updated sketch of pole 18 if your field review indicates that the data submitted with the original application is incorrect.
- d) Pole Nos. 14 (#10743), 15 (#10765), 20 (#10901), "B" (Switch Pole), and "E" (#11097): Your facilities are installed at a height greater than we would normally allow to provide the necessary clearances to our existing and future facilities. Since there is adequate space at the present time, we will allow you to remain the present attachment height. Therefore, we grant conditional approval to attach to these poles subject to future modifications by the District. If the District adds or changes facilities, we will notify you so that you can relocate your facilities as required. If you cannot relocate your facilities such that a taller pole will be necessary, we will install a taller pole at your expense. Also note that we question the accuracy of your field measurements for HOAs as shown on the sketch for pole 20. Please provide us with an updated sketch of pole 20 if your field review indicates that the data submitted with the original application is incorrect.
- e) There is an additional pole, not included on your application, located between pole no. 26 (east riser pole) and the pole with address #11097. For clarity, we have assigned the following designations so that you can proceed with the required modifications as noted above:

- A – East Riser Pole (pole #26 as listed on your application)
- B – 12.47kV Switch Pole
- C – pole with address #11061
- D – pole with address #11079
- E – pole with address #11097

Please resubmit the pole sketches for these 5 poles, starting with the east riser pole no. 26, and renumbering them through 30, so that we can have a proper and accurate record for this area. Note that this changes the total contacts for this application from 29 to 30.

I direct your attention to Section 12 of our License Agreement, which states the following:

*Licensee will obtain from public authorities and private owners of real property any and all permits, licenses or grants necessary for the lawful exercise of the permission granted by any application approved hereunder; and Licensee shall submit to Licensor evidence of compliance with the foregoing requirements prior to or at the time of making application for permission to place said equipment on said pole or poles.*

The subject applications each contain locations where your facilities cross or longitudinally occupy areas of Interstate 80, Highway 267 and Highway 89 North, and cross Union Pacific's railroad tracks near the Olympic Heights subdivision and the downtown Truckee area at Highway 267, as depicted on your applications. Since copies of your encroachment permits were not included in your applications, we assume that you will be applying to the affected agencies. It is critical that you obtain the appropriate easements or permits first so that the controlling party's (e.g. Caltrans) technical, safety or other requirements for crossing their property or facilities can be identified. Only after these requirements are known, and made available to the District pursuant to Section 12 above, can the District properly evaluate the subject poles (see above) in your applications to determine if we can accommodate your facilities on our existing structures.

As it would be an inefficient use of District resources to evaluate the subject poles without first having knowledge of Caltrans's or Union Pacific's requirements, we await receipt of a copy of the appropriate permits. In the meantime, we will perform our evaluations on the balance of the poles in each application. If we have not received copies of your permits by the end of our evaluation of any particular application, we will not delay in giving you our approval for that application, however the subject poles (see table) will not be included in our review or approval. Once you are in receipt of the appropriate permits, we can evaluate the subject poles in each case.

If USA Media does not receive the necessary permits for these crossings and occupations, your existing facilities must be removed from the subject poles in an expeditious manner.

**Subject: Pole Attachment Application No. 99-8**

In performing our review of the subject application, we note that a pole was completely missed between poles 3 and 4 as listed in the application. The missing pole is at address #11380 and is located directly in front of Amerigas Propane at 11380 Donner Pass Rd. This becomes a serious issue because the data for the poles past pole no. 3 is suspect. For instance, your application depicts the span length between poles 4 (#11400) and 5 (#14520) as 85 feet when it is actually 210 feet. So are the attachment heights listed for pole no. 4 (#11400) *really* for pole no. 4 or are they for the missing pole? Using another example, we note that pole no. 20 (#11840) is physically located immediately adjacent to the east side of Northwoods Blvd. But as depicted on your map, it is the *second* pole east of Northwoods Blvd. So are the attachment heights listed for pole no. 20 *really* for pole no. 20 or are they for some other pole? Therefore, I have serious concerns about the accuracy of your pole data from pole no. 3 to the end pole, specifically with regards to height of attachment, pole height and class, and span length information being listed for the correct pole. Note that we are NOT simply asking for information concerning only the missing pole. As noted above, we have shown and believe that errors have propagated through your data because this pole was missed. We request that you reexamine and confirm all pole data past pole no. 3 and resubmit this information at your earliest convenience.

Therefore, we deem the information in your application incomplete and await receipt of additional and/or corrected information as necessary before we can complete our review and approval. If you have any questions, please call me at 582-3969.

**Subject: Pole Attachment Application No. 99-6**

In performing our review of the subject application, there appears to be a large discrepancy between the actual number of poles as observed in our field review and as listed in the application. The application contains 9 poles starting from the Olympic Heights area along Glenshire Drive ( which picks up immediately where App. 99-5 stops), crosses Union Pacific railroad tracks, crosses the Truckee River, and terminates at pole no. 9 which is the second pole south of the Truckee River. However, in our field review we observed that your stringing equipment continues along our distribution pole line past pole no. 9 until it intersects a pole line containing communication conductors only, near the Truckee Sanitary District offices. At this point we note that your facilities transition to this communication pole line. We count seven (7) additional District poles, past pole no. 9, which USA Media has not included in this application, but which must be included as evidenced by your stringing equipment hanging from District poles and your obvious intention to leave our pole line at the intersection point with the communication pole line. Please clarify whether the 7 additional poles will be the subject of another application or whether USA Media wants them to be reviewed as a part of this application. If the latter is correct, then we deem your application incomplete and await receipt of application information for the seven additional poles in question.

Note that we have not yet received a copy of your permit from Union Pacific to cross the railroad tracks, located between poles 6 and 7. Note that we can neither review nor approve attachments to poles 6 and 7 until a copy of your permit has been received by the District (see our letter dated January 21). **Subject: Pole Attachment Application No. 99-7**

We have reviewed the subject application per the terms of our License Agreement. Permission is granted to attach to the poles subject to the following conditions:

1. Pole attachments to be modified as follows:

- a) Pole Nos. 3, 4, 5, and 9: Relocate your facilities so that they are only 12 inches above existing Pacific Bell telephone attachments. Note that your facilities should normally be installed 12 inches from existing telephone attachments. By installing your attachments incorrectly and then having to move them to the correct height, an unnecessary hole was drilled which weakens the pole. This is a prime example of why applications are required before facilities are initially installed.
- b) Pole Nos. 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 24 (#10995), 26 (#11045), and 27: Relocate your facilities to a point approximately 2 feet below your present attachment height, no higher than 22 feet above ground at these structures. This is another prime example of why applications are required before facilities are initially installed.
- c) Pole No. 13 (located immediately north of Donner Pass Rd.): The District will be replacing this existing 45 foot pole with a 50 foot pole in May of this year to accommodate the development of the Gateway East Project. After the District completes this pole replacement, transfer your attachment to a point no higher than 22 feet above ground at this structure.
- d) Pole Nos. 1 through 13: Since a copy of your grant of right of way from the private property owner for the parcel located immediately north of Interstate 80 was not attached to the application, we assume that you will be applying for said grant of right of way. Therefore, we grant conditional approval to attach to these poles subject to receiving a copy of your grant of right of way from the current private property owner. Note that in the future, we expect to see a copy of applicable grants of right of way with your application, pursuant to Section 12 of our License Agreement. I have enclosed a copy of our letter to the private property owner, Dennis Chez, apprising him of this issue.
