Dear Ms. Salas:

On December 20, 2000, Lee Schroeder, Vice President, Government and Regulatory Strategy for Cablevision Lightpath, Inc. ("Lightpath"), and the undersigned met with Jordan Goldstein, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Ness. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss intercarrier compensation. The parties also discussed the Commission's review of its finding that competitive LECs without access to unbundled local switching are not impaired in their ability to serve customers with four or more lines in density zone 1 in the top 50 metropolitan statistical areas where the incumbent LEC provides nondiscriminatory access to the enhanced extended link, or "EEL."
