## ORDER

By the Accounting Policy Division, Common Carrier Bureau:

1. The Commission's rules provide that the Common Carrier Bureau (Bureau) must issue a decision resolving a request for review of matters properly before it within ninety days unless the time period is extended.<sup>3</sup> The Bureau extended by thirty or sixty days the time period for considering these requests. The Bureau requires additional time to review the issues presented. Accordingly, we extend by an additional thirty (30) days the deadline by which the Bureau must take action regarding the instant requests for review of decisions by SLD.<sup>4</sup>

3. 
