MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

The Wireless Communications Association International, Inc. ("WCA"), hereby requests that the Commission grant WCA an extension of time within which to respond to the January 8, 2001 Motion for Stay of the Building Owners and Managers Association International *et al.* ("BOMA") filed in the above-captioned proceeding. Under Section 1.45(d) of the Commission's Rules, WCA's response was due on January 16, 2001. However, because WCA was not formally served with the document and did not learn of its filing until January 10, WCA has not had a sufficient opportunity to review the document and formulate a response. Accordingly, WCA requests an extension of its response deadline to January 26, 2001. Both the Commission's staff and

counsel for BOMA have been advised of the filing of this motion, and counsel for BOMA has indicated that BOMA has no objection to the requested extension.

WHEREFORE, WCA requests that the Commission issue an extension of time permitting WCA to file its response to the BOMA Motion for Stay on or before January 26, 2001.
