
On behalf of AOL Time Warner Inc., submitted herewith pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's rules are an original and one copy of this notice regarding a permitted oral *ex parte* presentation in the above-referenced proceeding. On January 12, 2001, Steven N. Teplitz, Vice President, Telecommunications Policy, spoke via telephone with Royce Dickens, Deputy Chief, Policy and Rules Division, Cable Services Bureau. Mr. Teplitz advised Ms. Dickens that the currently available version of the AOL Instant Messenger ("AIM") client software is version 4.3.x, not 4.1. He also noted that any concerns arising from cross-ownership interests between AT&T and AOL Time Warner Inc. would logically be resolved—and thus appropriately no longer apply—upon the divestiture by AT&T of its interest in Time Warner Entertainment Company, L.P.
