
**COMMENTS ON

Based upon our conversation with Bureau counsel, and in accordance with established Commission practice, it is TWC's understanding that the time extension described in the Bureau's motion applies to all interested parties desiring to oppose the Petition for Reconsideration filed by Bartholdi Cable Co. 
