
Dear Mr. Thompson:

This is in reference to the December 7, 2000 request for the dismissal of the petition for rule making which you submitted on behalf of Hewitt Radio Broadcasting Company ("Hewitt Radio"). Hewitt Radio requested the allotment of FM Channel 295A to Hewitt, Texas. In support of your request for dismissal, you state that Hewitt Radio and its engineering counsel have discovered after the filing of its petition, that changes in the radio spectrum now preclude the availability of Channel 295A at Hewitt, Texas.

In addition to the December 7th request for dismissal, you also submitted a declaration pursuant to Section 1.420(j) of the Commission's Rules stating that neither Hewitt Radio nor its principals has received any consideration for requesting the withdrawal of its petition for rule making.

Based on the above information, the aforementioned petition for rule making proposing the allotment of Channel 295A to Hewitt, Texas, is hereby dismissed.
