In the Joint Comments and Reply Comments of WorldCom, AT&T, Concert, Quest and Sprint in IB Docket No. 00-202 the carriers urged the Commission to issue an international detariffing order promptly and to grant an additional extension of the transition period for mandatory detariffing of interstate domestic services so that carriers will have the ability to detariff domestic and international services as of the same date.

Specifically, if the Commission extends the date for the mandatory detariffing of interstate domestic services to July 31, 2001, (1) AT&T will detariff its interstate domestic services no later than August 1, 2001; and (2) AT&T will detariff its international services no later than August 1, 2001, provided that by
