On Wednesday January 31, 2001, I spoke with Glenn Reynolds, Deputy Chief of the Common Carrier Bureau to discuss issues raised in the aforementioned dockets. Specifically, I stressed the importance of coordinating the implementation of international detariffing with domestic detariffing. In addition, I stated that the Commission should act quickly to raise the ceiling on lines at individual customer locations for which CLECs can obtain the UNE-P from the three-line limit that currently exists consistent with the filings that AT&T has made in the aforementioned docket.
