Yesterday the Competitive Telecommunications Association ("CompTel") and various Member Companies on its International Communications Committee met with representatives of the FCC's International Bureau, Common Carrier Bureau, and Consumer Information Bureau. CompTel was represented by Carol Ann Bischoff and the undersigned attorney, and the following persons represented CompTel ICC members: Doug Schoenberger and Mike Del Casino (AT&T); Michelle Mesen and LaRene Flack (Cable & Wireless USA); Marcy Greene (Excel); Tricia Paoletta (Level 3 Communications); John Kure (Qwest); Brian Cute (Teleglobe); Mindy Ginsburg (Viatel); and Karen Reidy (WorldCom). The following FCC employees attended the meeting: Rebecca Arbogast; Lisa Choi; Margaret Egler; Claudia Fox; Marlo Go; Jamie Metz; and Judy Nitsche.

During the meeting, CompTel and its members discussed the possibility of extending the deadline for the detariffing of domestic mass market services until the end of July, 2001. In addition, the parties discussed the desire of some CompTel member companies to detariff some or all of their international services at the same time as they detariff domestic mass market services. At the same time, other CompTel members indicated that they will need a
