ERRATUM

Released: February 2, 2001

On January 22, 2001, the Commission released a Memorandum Opinion and Order (FCC 01-29) in the captioned docket authorizing Southwestern Bell to provide in-region interLATA service in the States of Kansas and Oklahoma. These errata correct the following non-substantive errors in the released text prior to publication of the complete item in the FCC Record:

- 1. A new Ordering Clause is added, to follow paragraph 287:

"IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion to strike filed by Sprint Communications Company on January 18, 2001, IS DENIED."

- 2. The Ordering Clause in paragraph 288 is replaced with the following:

"IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that we waive our procedural rules regarding the consideration of late-filed evidence, but as a condition of this waiver, we delay the effective date of this Order by 43 days from the date of release. Therefore, this Order SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE March 7, 2001."
