

Our experience with FMs has been a frustrating one. We have an 8 year old son who is moderately hearing impaired. A functioning FM system is vital to his ability to learn in a classroom with other kids.

We have spent four frustrating years in different schools with different FM Systems attempting to find one that works right without interference. Not only have we had to switch FM manufacturers but we also have to experiment with channels and move classrooms to avoid interference. We just recently bought a new expensive FM system from Phonak because they allege that they have a clearer bandwidth. This was our last hopr to have a functioning FM.

I urge the government not to crowd what appears to be a very crowded space already with cell traffic and let these kids **hear** without interference so that they can learn.
