Mid-Rivers Telephone Cooperative, Inc. ("Mid-Rivers") hereby submits its report regarding the implementation of 711 access to all relay services pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") Second Report and Order in CC Docket No. 92-105.¹

In its Second R&O, the Commission urged wireless carriers to file a report with the Commission if they believed that they would not be able to implement wireless 711 access to Telecommunications Relay Services ("TRS") by the October 1, 2001 deadline. Mid-Rivers, a common carrier that provides wireless voice transmission services in addition to wireline services in the state of Montana, hereby files this instant report notifying the Commission that software routing and translation issues with its switch manufacturer, Siemens, may prevent it from meeting the October 1, 2001 deadline.

Mid-Rivers anticipates being able to perform 711 call routing functionality on a timely basis and is working diligently with Siemens engineers to resolve the software routing and translation issues. However, as of this date, it is not known whether these issues will be resolved by the Commission's deadline.




