

I oppose the reduction in the radio spectrum for Fm users. I am an educational audiologist for the Milwaukee Public Schools. We service well over 400 hearing impaired students and new ones are literally discovered everyday. At one school site we already have future concerns about running out of FM channels to satisfy our students self contained and mainstream classroom needs. Selling off a portion of this radio spectrum will most likely make this occur much sooner. In addition my colleagues elsewhere have difficulty getting a FM channel to work without interference and the availability of FM channels has been important in solving this problem.
