Dear Ms. Salas:

On March 1, 2001, FCC staff members convened an engineering meeting to discuss interference issues between satellite DARS and WCS licensees. FCC staff members present included: Ron Netro, Tom Stanley and John O'Connor (from the Wireless Bureau) and Ron Repasi, Rockie Patterson, and Rosalee Chiara (from the International Bureau). Present for satellite DARS licenses were Jeff Snyder and Phil Barsky (XM Satellite Radio), and Rob Briskman and Mark Gaudino (Sirius Satellite Radio). WCS licensees were represented by Bob Friday and Mike Hamra (Metricom), Bob Saunders and John Tehan (Bell South), Bob Maxwell (AT&T Wireless), and George Harter (MSI). The discussion concerned interference and coverage calculation methodology, and general issues about RF design and filtering that could minimize inter-system interference. The parties agreed to submit additional technical


