

I am a frequent user of the new MURS service.

I purchased two handheld radios and use them for both business and personal use. Because of the ERP restrictions placed on this new service, and because most new personal users will be using handheld radios only, the impact to existing business users on these frequencies has been and will likely continue to be minimal at worst. The typical personal use is in suburban applications, theme parks, family outings, and car-to-car - and they have caused no significant interference issues to date, and are not likely to in the future.

The new MURS service is a valuable addition to the quality of life of the individual, and the FCC is to be commended for creating this service. I implore the Commission to disregard complaints from Motorola - who seem to be more concerned with corporate profits and maintenance of their market position, rather than the good of the people.
