Dear Ms. Cameron:

In response to your request, below is the cite and associated explanation. Verizon offers interconnection arrangements that allow a CLEC to interconnect at only one technically feasible point in each LATA for the delivery of its local traffic. For example, Verizon's agreement with MCI Metro provides that MCI and BA shall designate at least one [physical point of interconnection] in the LATA in which MCI originates local traffic and interconnects with BA. See Application, Appendix J, Tab 22, Attachment IV at 2. The MCI agreement further provides that [u]pon MCI's request for additional points of interconnection, BA will interconnect with MCI at any technically feasible point. Id. Any requesting CLEC may seek the same terms and conditions as those contained in MCI's agreement under Section 252(i).
