For good cause stated, the unopposed Enforcement Bureau's Motion To Change Hearing Date previously set for June 5, 2001, IS GRANTED in part in order to accommodate counsel's schedule.

However, a new hearing date will not be set until the Prehearing Conference that is to be held on April 3, 2001. See Order FCC 01M-03, released March 8, 2001. The Presiding Judge has already set a hearing on another case that is scheduled to be held out of town during the week of June 18, 2001. It would not be feasible to try to accommodate this case the week before, particularly since there has not yet been a discussion of the preparation and discovery that will be requested by the parties in this case, and there has been no estimate made of the time required.

Accordingly, the hearing date that was set for June 5, 2001, IS CANCELLED and a new date SHALL BE RESET at the Prehearing Conference.
