Subsequent to filing an ex parte letter on March 1, 2001, regarding a February 27<sup>th</sup> meeting between Copper Mountain and FCC staff members Johanna Mikes, Stacy Pies, Kathy Farroba, and Rodney McDonald, we discovered an error in the letter.

On the second page, first full paragraph, last two lines should be changed to read:

Generally, Copper Mountain stressed the importance of allowing carriers to offer services that call for constant bit rate applications per virtual path as opposed to limiting such applications to virtual circuits, which would allow the competitive carrier to have a dedicated pipe with constant bit rate that all of its end users could share.

The current last sentence of the paragraph should be deleted.
