STATEMENT FOR THE RECORD

WNNX LICO, Inc. ("WWWQ"), licensee of WWWQ(FM) (formerly WHMA-FM), College Park, Georgia, by its counsel, respectfully submits this Statement for the Record in response to the Petition for Reconsideration ("Recon Petition II") filed by Preston W. Small ("Small") on March 12, 2001 in this proceeding. Recon Petition II was filed in response to the *Memorandum Opinion and Order*, DA-01-333, released February 9, 2001, which denied a Petition for Reconsideration filed by Small in this proceeding on June 16, 2000 (Recon Petition). Pursuant to Section 1.429 of the Commission's Rules, WWWQ is entitled to file comments responsive to that pleading as provided in the Commission's release of a public notice, and publication in the Federal Register.
