Based upon funding denial of the above noted application and FRN by the SLD, this letter is to inform you that we wish to again appeal the funding decision for the above noted FRN. The type of service for the FRN was modified on the SLD end from Internet Access to Internal Connections, then to Telecommunication Services and finally deemed not eligible for funding. The type of service should have never been changed and should be as originally requested - Internet Access. This service is for the lease of fiber optic lines allowing the Palmyra Macedon Central School District Internet Access. Our documentation shows that this request is for a lease of the fiber line, and is only used for data.

Attached is a copy of the Funding Commitment report with the area in question noted, a copy of the fiber lease agreement with the vendor that was attached with the application originally, and a copy of the USAC appeal decision letter.

After thorough review and investigation of all relevant facts, the Schools and Libraries Division ("SLD") of the Universal Service Administrative Company ("USAC") has made its decision in regard to your appeal of SLD's Year Three Funding Commitment Decision for the Application Number indicated above. This letter explains the basis of SLD's decision. The date of this letter begins the 30-day time period for appealing this decision to the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"). If your letter of appeal included more than one Application Number, please note that for each application for which an appeal is submitted, a separate letter is sent.

Funding Request Number: 438589  
Decision on Appeal: **Denied in full**  
Explanation:

- Your appeal claims that this is a request for leased fiber lines used for Internet access. Accordingly, you would like the SLD to change the category of service for this request to Internet access, as was originally requested, and provide discounts for this request.
- After thorough review of your appeal it has been determined that this is not a request for internal connections. Your documentation indicates this is a request for leased fiber lines to be used for voice, video, and data. According to program rules fiber lines used for voice and video are requests for telecommunications service, and must be classified as such. Therefore, the category of service for your request has been changed to telecommunications service in accordance with program rules.

- Your Form 471 indicates that you selected a vendor that is ineligible to provide telecommunications service under this program: {E.C.C. Technologies, Inc.}. FCC regulations provide that only telecommunications carriers are eligible for universal service support. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 54.501(a). FCC regulations define telecommunications carriers as any provider of telecommunications services, and telecommunications services as “the offering of telecommunications for a fee directly to the public, or to such classes of users as to be effectively available directly to the public, regardless of the facilities used.” 47 C.F.R. § 52.5(g), (h). Because this mirrors the common law definition of a “common carrier,” the FCC has determined that to be eligible to receive universal service support, the provider must provide telecommunications services on a common carrier basis. *See* Federal-State Joint Board on Universal Service, CC Docket No. 96-45, *Report and Order*, FCC 97-157 ¶ 134 (rel. May 8, 1997).

If you believe there is a basis for further examination of your application, you may file an appeal with the Federal Communications Commission, Office of the Secretary, 445 12<sup>th</sup> Street, SW, Room TW-A325, Washington, DC 20554. Please reference CC Docket Nos. 96-45 and 97-21 on the first page of your appeal. Before preparing and submitting your appeal, please be sure to review the FCC rules concerning the filing of an appeal of an Administrator’s Decision, which are posted on the website at <[www.universalservice.org](http://www.universalservice.org)>. **You must file your appeal with the FCC no later than 30 days from the date on this letter for your appeal to be filed in a timely fashion.**
