
Dear Ms. Salas:

Jacksonville Educators Broadcasting, Inc., licensee of noncommercial station WJEB(TV), channel 59, Jacksonville, Florida ("JEB"), by its counsel, hereby submits this letter in connection with the Commission's *Third Report and Order*, FCC 01-25 (Rel. Jan. 23, 2001), in the above-referenced proceeding (the "*Third R&O*").

On March 16, 2001, Paxson Communications Corporation and other television station owners that collectively represent forty-two percent (42%) of the existing analog stations in the Channel 59-69 Band filed with the Commission a *Petition for Clarification and Reconsideration* of the *Third R&O* (the "*Petition*"). JEB has reviewed the *Petition* and hereby advises the Commission that it supports the positions set forth in the *Petition*.
