By the Accounting Policy Division, Common Carrier Bureau:


1. The Accounting Policy Division (Division) has under consideration the above-captioned Requests for Review of decisions issued by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company.<sup>1</sup> These requests seek review of SLD decisions pursuant to section 54.719(c) of the Commission's rules.<sup>2</sup>

2. The Commission's rules provide that the Common Carrier Bureau (Bureau) must issue a decision resolving a request for review of matters properly before it within ninety days unless the time period is extended.<sup>3</sup> The Bureau extended by sixty days the time period for considering the Requests for Review.<sup>4</sup> The Bureau requires additional time to review the issues presented. Accordingly, we extend by an additional thirty (30) days the deadline by which the Bureau must take action regarding the instant Requests for Review of decisions by the Schools and Libraries Division.<sup>5</sup>

3. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to section 54.724(a) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 54.724(a), that the time period for taking action in the above-captioned Requests for Review of decisions by the Schools and Libraries Division IS EXTENDED BY thirty days to to April 19, 2001, for the Request for Review filed by St. Jean Vianney School, Baton Rouge, Louisiana; to May 10, 2001 for the Requests for Review filed by Cleveland Municipal School District, Cleveland, Ohio, for Funding Request Numbers 418921 and 421840; to May 10, 2001, for the Request for Review filed by Total Com USA, Ltd.; to May 14, 2001 for the Request for Review filed by Doolittle West School, Chicago, Illinois, and; to May 16, 2001 for the Request for Review filed by Seventh Day Adventist School, Milwaukee, Wisconsin.
