Dear Ms. Salas:

On April 6, 2001, Craig Donaldson, Cynthia Clugy and Martha Jenkins on behalf of SCC Communications Corp. met with Blaise Scinto and other members of the Wireless Bureau to discuss issues related to the above referenced docket regarding Phase II deployment and other emergency notification issues.

Specifically, SCC Communications discussed the need for the Commission to weigh carriers' request for waiver of the Phase II implementation schedule on a case by case basis, i.e., balance the Commission's objective to further the public interest regarding the delivery of emergency services to wireless consumers with the wireless carriers' stated interest, giving consideration to technology that might be available today and that might obviate the need to request a waiver or a delay in implementation.
