We are requesting that the FCC review the denial of our letter of appeal dated July 27, 2000 and reconsider the decision to deny in full FRN 320712. To help with your decision, I am providing you with a history of our Ameritech contract and Erate filing, along with the associated paperwork.

Year 1:

January 5, 1998 - Kalamazoo Public Schools (KPS) entered into a 5-year contract for tariffed services with Ameritech for basic voice service. (Attachment #1a)
February 26, 1998 – KPS filed FCC Form 470 for POTS under a preexisting contract and received confirmation from the SLC that the 470 was properly completed. The 470 was assigned the Universal Service Control Number: 47445000044604. Within the confirmation letter, the SLC wrote: "According to the FCC rules, because your Form 470 lists only descriptions of services currently being provided under pre-existing contracts, it will not be necessary to post your application on the SLC web site. There is, however a 28-day waiting period before the filing of an FCC Form 471 for qualified pre-existing contracts. Accordingly, one or more Schools and Libraries Universal Service Services Ordered and Certification Forms(s) (FCC Form 471) related to this Form 470 may be submitted on or after 03-25-98. A properly completed Form 471, with a signed Form 471 certification, as well as a signed Form 470 certification, must be received by SLC no later than 04-15-98 in order to meet the SLC 75-day window." No 470 filed for "POTS" because of the existing multiyear contract signed pursuant to the posting of a Form 470 in a previous funding year.

The March 19, 2001 letter from the USAC references a signed contract for new services dated 1/5 99. As noted in attachment #1a, the contract was signed 1/5/98, making it eligible for a preexisting contract. Should we have referenced Form 470 USCN: 474450000044604 from year 1 instead? We have been under the same multi-year contract with Ameritech for tariffed services for year 1, 2 and 3.

We realize this is a huge program with extensive application and reimbursement procedures. We do our best to meet the requirements with limited staff. Please consider our appeal. The Erate program has provided us with technology improvements for our students that would otherwise not have been possible to implement!



1. CUSTOMER LIABILITY FOR FULL TERMINATION OF SERVICE

Termination Charges for full discontinuance of Ameritech Centrex Service at the request of Customer and prior to the end of the selected Service Term is calculated by Ameritech as follows:

Eighty percent (80%) of the contracted for station lines, as referenced on the attached Centrex Service Pricing Sheet MULTIPLIED times the number of remaining months in the selected Service Term, as referenced on the attached Confirmation of Service Order MULTIPLIED times fifty percent (50%).

2. CUSTOMER LIABILITY FOR PARTIAL TERMINATION OF SERVICE

In the event that Customer contracted for station line quantities fall below the Line Capacity Commitment noted on the attached Confirmation of Service Order the following applies:

Termination Charges for partial discontinuance of Ameritech Centrex Service at the request of Customer and prior to the end of the selected Service Term is calculated by Ameritech as follows:

Eighty percent (80%) of the Line Capacity Commitment, as referenced on the attached Confirmation of Service Order MULTIPLIED times the associated monthly rate(s), as referenced on the attached Centrex Service Pricing Sheet MULTIPLIED times the number of remaining months in the selected Service Term, as referenced on the attached Confirmation of Service Order MULTIPLIED times fifty percent (50%).

3. TERMINATION OF SERVICE DUE TO OFFICE MOVES

In the event Customer moves the principle service location, as referenced on the attached Ameritech Michigan Terms and Conditions page, termination charges will not be applicable if any of the following apply:

- The move is within its service wire center area and the same or greater number of lines exist after the move.
- Move of secondary location(s) in the same Ameritech Centrex Service system is moved within its serving wire center area or outside of its serving wire center area.
- Move is between wire center areas and both wire centers are served by Ameritech Michigan switches, with station lines not to exceed 300.
- Move is between wire centers served by an Ameritech Michigan switch and an off premises located Ameritech Michigan switch, with station lines not to exceed 300.

When the move of the principle service location is between wire centers, a new Confirmation of Service Order is required for the new location and the new Confirmation of Service Order must be for a period equal to or greater than the time remaining in the existing Confirmation of Service Order and for the same or greater number of contracted for station lines.

All station lines involved in a relocation of Ameritech Centrex Service are subject to then current installation and nonrecurring charges.




