Dear Ms. Salas:

On April 11, 2001, on behalf of the Personal Communications Industry Association ("PCIA") I met with Jim Schlichting, David Furth, Roger Noel and Wilbert Nixon of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (WTB) to discuss the status of the referenced proceeding. We discussed potential Commission decisions to deviate from the PCIA NPCS Bandplan submitted to the FCC last summer. In particular, we discussed potential changes to service area designations, the relative allocation of nationwide and MTA service areas at the expense of regional allocations and the importance of retaining unpaired 12.5 KHz spectrum as noted in the PCIA plan.
